# Culture, flavours and tradition

#### 1st Day

#### **Aosta Valley**

Arrival in the Aosta Valley. Accommodation, dinner and overnight in hotel.

#### 2<sub>nd</sub> Day

Aosta - Pont Saint Martin - Bard Breakfast in the hotel and departure to Aosta. Guided visit of the city center on foot. The visit begins with the Roman Bridge, near the Arch of Augustus and leads the group through the pedestrian zone, from where they can admire the monumental complex Sant'Orso (Church with monastery with frescoes and Bell Tower), as also the church of San Lorenzo with its archaeological excavations of the early Christian Basilica, Porta Preatoria and the Theater (only external visits). Follows the Emilio Chanoux Square, for visiting its church of Santa Maria Assunta. Along the walls of the city the group ca[n see many medieval buildings, as for example the new tower, Tower of the Leper, the Pailleron Tower and so on. In the afternoon, visit in Pont Saint Martin and in Bard. Visit of the castle and the medieval village, whose 20 houses have been declared national monument (Entrance of the castle against payment. Please ask us!). Return in the hotel. Dinner and overnight.

#### 3rd Day

#### Courmayeur - Sarre

Breakfast in the hotel and departure to Courmayeur. In the morning visit of the city center. In the afternoon visit of the castle of Sarre. Later, visit of a regional bacon factory with tasting. Return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight.

#### **Aosta**

#### Classical Halfday Itinerrary with guide

The tour is entirely on foot. The journey begins on the Roman bridge near the Arch of Augustus and continue along the pedestrian street where you can admire the monumental complex of Sant'Orso (church with frescoes and Roman Bell Tower, Palazzo del Priorat), then it goes to the church of San Lorenzo with the archaeological site of early Christian Basilica, Porta Praetoria and the Roman theater (outdoor). Passing the Piazza Emilio Chanoux, City Hall, and possibilty to visit the church of Santa Maria Assunta. Along the city walls you can see more structures of the Middle Ages and the Roman Age such as the Towerl Lebbroso, Tower Pailleron and more.

#### **Castle Fenis**

Fenis is one of the most famous castles, mainly because it consists of several towers, which makes it an exceptional castle and give the visitors the impression of a fairytale castle.

As an emblem of the Aosta Valley of medieval architecture, it is now one of the major tourist attractions in the region.

#### **Castle Sarre**

The castle is located on a hill, overlooking Aosta and dominates the access to the upper valley. It has an elongated structure with a square tower in the center and is used as a museum of the presence of Savoy in Aosta Valley.

#### **Bard**

The building, a fortified complex, whose history goes back to the High Middle Ages, belonged to the Lords of Bard and Savoy, is now a cultural fortress. In 1996, the castle was restored, the various parts of the imposing building, house of the Museum of the Alps, Museum of the Western Alps and "The Alps of Children", an interactive course for younger explorers, "prisons" a historic military site as well as rooms for temporary exhibitions and a parade scene devoted by many cultural, musical and theatrical events. The tip of the rocky promontory, is accessible via panoramic lifts.



#### Rivoli

The Castle of Rivoli is one of the most important symbols of the dynasty of Savoy, part of a design that in the '500 lead to the creation of the so-called Crown of Delights, a symbol of absolute power. The complex consists of two buildings: the castle, in its aspect of the eighteenth century and the Manica Lunga, built in 1600, as a Pinakothek of Duke Carlo Emanuele I. The two buildings are seperated in the atrium by columns and pillars, a project by Juvarra. The two buildings belong to two different times and this has been proven thanks to the different characters. The castle now houses the Museum of Contemporary Art.

#### Sacra di San Michele

Millennium abbey of the Benedictines built at the top of Mount Pirchirianot. The Sacra of San Michele is the symbol of Piedmont since 1994.

#### Superga

The basilica was designed by Juvarra and is situated on the hill of Superga, where you have a magnificent view of the city of Turin. In the crypt are the graves of the Royal House of Savoy, at the request of King Vittorio Amedeo III.

#### Venaria Reale

The Venaria Reale is a huge complex near Turin, with 80,000 square meters of monumental Palace and 50 acres of gardens, properties that are located near the historic center of Venaria, already page the seventeenth century and 3000 hectares of the La Mandria Park.


It is a masterpiece of architecture and landscape, UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1997 and opened to the public since 2007, after the major restoration in Europe.

The tour begins with Piazza Cadorna, where you can see the sights "Ago e Filo», dedicated to the devoted Haute Couture. You can also admire the modern station Cadornan, which was renovated by architect Gae Aulenti, and is known internationally for the development of the renowned Museum d'Orsay; Quadrilatero della Moda, which is defined by four main streets (Via Monte Napoleone, Via della Spiga, Via Sant'Andrea and Via Manzoni), which owns the heart of fashion with the most prestigious boutiques of Italian designers.

#### Chic Milan

#### Classical halfday itinerary

Tour of the Quarter "dei Navigli", a district that is crossed by artificial canals.

Navigli, which have a romantic charm is animated by several restaurants, artists' shops, artisans, and Discotheques, so this is the most beautiful part of the city, charming and quiet during the day, but revived in the late afternoon, time for the aperitif, a real local tradition; Porta Ticinese, dedicated to the triumphal entry of Napoleone Bonaparte in Milan.

The Citadel (the upper part of the Medieval city with fortifications dating from the  $14_{\text{th}}$  century), Via Gombito and Via Colleoni, Piazza Vecchia, (the very heart of the town that is lined with beautiful buildings such as the  $12_{\text{th}}$  century Palace of Justice and its majestic bell tower), the Palladian library and Contarini Fountain, the cathedral of Saint Mary Major (which was built between the  $12_{\text{th}}-17_{\text{th}}$  century and houses the tomb of the musician Donizetti), Colleoni Chapel (a Renaissance mausoleum commissioned by General Colleoni and built in polychrome marble with frescoes by Tiepolo) and the Rocca, a  $14_{\text{th}}$  century fortress that offers spectacular panoramic views of the city.

#### Como

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit:

The Cathedral, Broletto (the seat of the Medieval town hall), Piazza Verdi with its beautiful monuments dating from various periods in history, the Medieval walls, the neoclassical theatre, the former Casa del Fascio, Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, the Romanesque Basilica of San Fedele and the beautiful square with the same name, the imposing tower and Piazza della Vittoria, with a statue dedicated to Garibaldi.

#### Tremezzo, Villa Carlotta

Villa Carlotta is a place of rare beauty: here the masterpieces of nature and people live together in harmony on 70,000 square meters of gardens and museums. The park of Villa Carlotta is famous for the blooming rhododendrons and azaleas in the spring, which are available in 150 varieties. However, in any period of the year it's worth a visit: The ancient varieties of camellias and cedars, the old redwoods and giant plane trees greet visitors in an environment that was created over the centuries by the garden architects.

#### Mantua

Since July 2008, Mantonva takes part with Sabbioneta of the heritage of humanity by UNESCO.

#### Classical halfday itinerary

Visit of Piazza Sordello, a large rectangle of gravel; Cathedral of St. Peter, testimony of three eras.

To the right of the cathedral, is the Domus Magna and the Captain's Palace. Between Piazza Sordello and the old town, you can see an arch. Then it goes on to Piazza Broletto, with the Fountain of the Dolphins at its center; on the one side, the Argentario Arc and on the other, the city tower, with its bell. The heart of Mantua: Piazza delle Erbe, the majestic Palazzo della Ragione, La Rotonda of San Lorenzo. The trading house fills the space between the dome of the Basilica of St. Andrea, the tower and the Palace of the Podestà.



#### Sanremo

Known as the "city of flowers" and from the Italian Song Festival. Along the marble-paved, seafront road Corso Imperatrice to the Russian church that stands next to the Liberty-style Municipal Casino at Via Matteotti, with elegant boutiques. The tour then crosses the Old City, (known as "La Pigna", due to its characteristic shape that reminds that of a "pigna" or pinecone), to reach the Basilica-Concathedral of San Siro built in Romanesque-Gothic style. On top of the "Pigna" stands the beautiful Sanctuary of Madonna della Costa.

#### **The Cinque Terre**

Excursion program: departure from La Spezia and continuing by bus along the panoramic route of the pleasant Manarola. To discover La Spezia from the top, the importance of its Military Arsenal, the view at the Golf and the Apuanes Alps. A few kilometers further we will arrive at the coast of the Cinque Terre, a dizziness coast, shaped by dry stone terraces, a location recognized as National Park in 1999 and UNESCO protected territory since 1997 as a system of naturalistic environmental interest. Going down to Manarola and continuing on foot to visit the village. Proceeding the nice walk along the Lovers' Way or "Via dell'Amore", an excavated street in the rocks form the last century, arrival at Riomaggiore, another picturesque village of the Cinque Terre, with its "houses tours" colored buildings along the flood. The trip goes further by train in the direction of Monterosso where lunch is foreseen. In the afternoon, some free time to spend. Return by boat to La Spezia, without stops.

## Gulf of Tigullio and Portofino

The visit departs by ferryboat from the small port of Rapallo and continues along the coast, passing the

picturesque villages of Santa Margherita Ligure and Portofino to San Fruttuoso di Capodimonte. Here there will be a half hour stop for a quick visit to this picturesque and uncontaminated village that still has only 16 inhabitants and boasts an ancient abbey dating from the ninth century A.D. The return journey begins with a half hour boat trip to Portofino, the most famous village in Liguria, where there will be a guided tour and some free time. Return to Rapallo by boat.

**ATTENTION:** Coaches are not allowed to enter the town of Portofino; you can only reach Portofino by boat.

#### Genoa

The panoramic bus tour departs from the Aquarium car park and proceeds to Piazza Cavour and Corso Quadrio, along the ancient city walls, to the old fishing village of "Boccadasse". The Albaro quarter, with its Liberty-style 16th century villas, Piazza della Vittoria until the Piazza Manin and Piazza Dante. From here, it is possible to continue the tour on foot. The standard tour includes the Ducal Palace, the Cathedral, and Columbus' house, Soprana Gate, Piazza San Matteo, Campetto and the old Port.

#### Monaco and Montecarlo

In the Principality of Monaco there is a chance to visit the marvelous exotic gardens that contains more than 6,000 cactus plants from Mexico and Africa as well as the Anthropological Museum and beautiful panoramic views over the entire country. The tour proceeds in the old town with a visit to the Cathedral (where the tombs of the Princes are) and the Palace (changing of the guard). The tour continues along the Port, where numerous yachts are anchored, towards Monte Carlo with its elegant hotels and the Café de Paris. Visitors will also have the opportunity to visit the famous and extremely popular Casino before returning along the Principality's "Grande Cornice" (with possibility to visit Nizza).

## 🖪 THE ITALIAN LAKES

"What can one say of Lake Maggiore, of the Borromean Islands, of Lake Como, except to pity people who do not go mad over them?' (Stendhal, 1829)

#### **Borromean Islands**

Isola Bella was a small island of bare rock until 1632 when Count Carlo III Borromeo built the Borromeo Palace. This splendid Baroque-style building is renowned for its Italian garden, which contains many rare and exotic plants. Isola Dei Pescatori is a picturesque fishing village with a beautiful church, narrow, winding streets and a charming walkway through the north of the island. Isola Madre boasts the Borromeo Palace, which has one of the oldest and most beautiful botanical gardens in Italy.

#### Stresa and Villa Pallavicino

The "pearl of the lake" is, without doubt, one of the most beautiful and prestigious lakeside destinations in Europe. Villa Pallavicino Park, on the other hand, is famous for its huge variety of ancient trees, its beautiful gardens and flowers, and the spectacular panoramic views over the lake and surrounding mountains.

#### **Pallanza** and Villa Taranto

Pallanza, which is of Roman origin, is extremely proud of its beautiful monuments including the Romanesque church of Madonna di Campagna, Villa Remigio, Villa Giulia and Villa Taranto. Villa Taranto has an English-style botanical garden that boasts more than 20,000 different species of plants and trees.

#### Lake Orta and Giulio Island

Orta (a Medieval borough), Sacro Monte Park (situated about 1 km away on a hillside, covered in lush vegetation and woods, where there is a complex of religious buildings consisting of about twenty chapels consecrated to Saint Francis of Assisi) and San Giulio Island (which has an early Christian basilica).

#### The Hermitage of Saint Catherine

This building, which was proclaimed a national monument in 1914, is carved into the rock and clings to a cliff about 18 meters above the lake. It can either be reached by land (after a steep climb of 267 steps) or by ferryboat across the lake (and then 80 steps on foot).

#### **Lake Maggiore Express**

Maggiore for three hours, to admire the Borromeo Islands, the Cannero castles and the Brissage Islands and a beautiful shoreline with quaint villages and picturesque bays. You will have the opportunity to have lunch on board (obligatory reservation). You will arrive in Locarno in the afternoon. For an hour and a half you will cross a wild and romantic region with the Centovalli railway: meadows alternate with daring bridges, streams of the purest water, vineyards, and chestnut forests with villages clinging to mountain slopes.

#### Tremezzo. Villa Carlotta

Villa Carlotta built in the 18th century and partly modified in neoclassical style, with a grand flight of steps and an Italian garden (botanical garden).

#### Bellagio

Situated in a strategic position on the promontory that divides the two lower branches of the lake: this is the real jewel of the town. Its narrow streets, which are topped with arches, its superb aristocratic villas and its luxurious hotels, make it particularly interesting to visit.

#### Como

Typical itinerary for a half-day visit. The Cathedral, Broletto (the seat of the Medieval town hall), Piazza Verdi, with its beautiful monuments dating from various periods in history, the Medieval walls, the neoclassical theatre, the former Casa del Fascio, Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, the Romanesque Basilica of San Fedele (and the beautiful square with the same name), the imposing tower and Piazza Della Vittoria, with a statue dedicated to Garibaldi.

#### Sirmione

The poet Catullo used to call Sirmione "the pearl of all the islands and peninsulas" and indeed, it enjoys spectacular surroundings, set between clear blue waters and lush green olive groves. Particularly worth visiting are the Della Scala Fortress (with an interesting Roman lapidary art collection) and the Caves of Catullo (the remains of an imposing Roman villa).

#### Desenzano

This small but lively town is famous for its cathedral and the remains of a Roman villa dating from the beginning of the 4th century A.D. that boasts extremely beautiful polychrome mosaics.

#### Gardaland

St. Mark's Square (the very centre of city life), St. Mark's Basilica (that owes its outstanding beauty to the mosaics that adorn its walls, vaults and cupolas), the Doges' Palace (once the symbol of the glory of Venice) and the Bridge of Sighs, that connects the Palace to the prisons.

## Venice off the beaten track

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

Saint Zachariah's church and square, the church and square of Santa Maria Formosa, the church of Saints Joseph and Paul (where the tombs of the Doges are housed), Marco Polo's house, the Rialto Bridge and the "calli" or typical, narrow Venetian streets.

## The Islands of the Lagoon

Visit to three islands: Murano, famous for the workshops of its glass craftsmen and its unusual Y-shaped canal overlooked by Renaissance houses, Burano, the fishing village that is famous for lace and Torcello, which was once the residence of the Bishop and still has a famous cathedral.

#### Gondola Ride

A romantic tour of the city by gondola travelling along the Grand Canal, under bridges and along other smaller canals. There is also the possibility to book musicians to play a repertoire of Italian songs.

#### **Padua**

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

Saint Anthony's Basilica (this imposing Romanesque-Gothic style building, with eight cupolas and Byzantine-style bell towers, houses the mortal remains of the saint), Piazza delle Erbe and Piazza della Frutta (where a traditional and picturesque market is held every day), the Palace of Justice (the seat of the cities law courts), Pedrocchi Cafe and the famous University.

#### Verona

#### **Classical Halfday Itinerary**

The tour begins with a panoramic tour in by bus and on foot: Piazza Bra, with the fountain of Madonna Verona in its centre, one of the landmarks of the city and the arena (Roman amphitheater from the 1st century AD - C) Castel Vecchio, Porta Borsari, Piazza delle Erbe (picturesque square that is occupied by the old Roman forum of Verona), Piazza dei Signori, Scaligeri arc (such as the monumental Scaglieri graves in the courtyard of the Church of S. Maria Antica), Juliet's House (Facade with beautiful brick).

#### Vicenza

#### **Classical Halfday Itinerary**

The tour begins with the Olympic Theatre, designed by the architect Andrea Palladio in 1580 and continues with a stroll away through the streets of the city.

You can admire the church of Santa Corona (external) and Contrà Santa Corona. Continue to the Piazzetta Santo Stefano and crossing the Contra Porti. The "contra" are the roads that run through the city with historic buildings.

The tour ends at the Piazza dei Signori, the main square of the old town, originally a Roman forum and marketplace, and with the Palladian Basilica, once the seat of the public magistrates of Vicenza.

#### Venetian Villas

The Palladian villas have their seat in Veneto, especially in the province of Vicenza, designed by the architect Andrea Palladio (1508-1580). Twenty-four of these villas have been included in the World Heritage List of UNESCO in 1996, the registration of the historic center of Vicenza (with twenty-three buildings) came two years ago.

The term villa was always used to describe the house in the countryside, while the town, palace, this became the rule in Venice.

Several noble families who had a villa, also had a palace on the Grand Canal in Venice, and in most cases, palaces and villas were named with the family name, as Barbaro Foscari Palace, Villa Barbaro and Villa Foscari in Venice.

## Cortina D'Ampezzo and The Dolomites

A combination of majestic mountain peaks, green valleys and romantic landscapes to ensure that a day spent in these parts, where the people are generally courteous and very attached to their ageold traditions and customs, is truly unforgettable. Cortina d'Ampezzo is a world famous international ski resort that hosted the Winter Olympics in 1956.

#### **Trento**

Established to connect the Germanic and the Latin world, the city retains the sights and ancient traditions, its history, in a natural environment of incomparable beauty, which offers one of the highest levels of quality of life in Italy.

#### **Classic Half Day Tour**

We begin with the Castle Buonconsiglio (external visit), walk through the old town to admire the frescoes of the facades of Renaissance palaces and to reach finally the Dome.

The tour continues with a panoramic bus through the medieval quarter with tower houses in the new town and where you can also admire the facade of the museum "Museo di Scienze naturali" created by Renzo Piano (Opening July 2013). Here ends the Tour.

#### Bolzano

Bolzano is fascinated by its two faces: two souls that live in perfect harmony in a cultural exchange and language.

For centuries, the city was the center of the privileged trade between the Italian and Germanic regions. The character of this story now can be found in churches, palaces, streets and squares.

#### **Classic Half Day Tour**

Visit of he historical centre with the Piazza Walter and the Dome, Via Argentieri, i Portici, Piazza delle Erbe.

## Bressanone and the Abbey

Bressanone / Brixen, the oldest baroque town of Tyrol, is a perfect combination of Italian « Dolce Vita

» and sobriety, two aspects that make it unique. The abbey is one of the most impressive and best preserved monasteries in Tyrol.

A visit is equivalent to a walk through the most important epochs in the history of art: Romanesque, Gothic, Baroque and Rococo are still visible and can be admired in a harmonious combination.

In the basement of the abbey you can taste renowned wines, accompanied from excellent bacon, smoked sausages, cheese, local bread, all in a traditional atmosphere.

#### **Castel Tirolo**

It is the largest castle in South Tyrol.

Dominating the valley of Merano and the mouth of the Val Venosta and Val d'Adige, the castle is one of the most strategic positions to control the passage of troops and convoys.

The unusual architectural form has already let known from a distance, the power of the family and whose property are the different countries between Adige Valley and the Inn.

**Note:** The castle is only accessible by foot (20 minutes walk).

#### Merano

In the footsteps of the historic and artistic expressions of the city, you can walk in a constant play between the glorious past and a vibrant present along a route among its most representative places. Buildings full of charm as the palace of the Prince and the Cathedral of Saint-Nicolas, Piazza Terme, Piazza della Rena.

## and the Republic of San Marino

#### Bologna

Bologna is located between the river Po and the Apennines, and is the capital of the region of Emilia-Romagna. It is the seat of the oldest university in the Western world, the University of Bologna (1088). The cultural impact gave the University the nickname "La Dotta" (the knower). The city has other nicknames such as "La Rossa" (the Red), in allusion to his terracotta tiles and also for its political soul, and "La Grassa" (the fat) for its excellent cuisine.

#### **Classical Half Day Itinerary**

The tour begins with the famous Piazza Maggiore, famous for the valuable landscape of its buildings dating from the Middle Ages as the Accursio Palace, the Palace of the notaries, the facade of the Palazzo dei Banchi, the palace "Podestà", the Palace of King Enzo. In the middle of the square, the bronze Neptune fountain, a masterpiece of Giambologna and Tommaso Laureti, built to celebrate the papal power. The next step is dedicated to the church of Bologna and the Basilica of San Petronio: it is home to masterpieces of late Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque. Then the space Galvani is crossed to reach the imposing Archiginnasio Palace, the original site of the town's university. Its interior is decorated with more than 5,000 weapons. Subsequently, the visit of the amphitheater of anatomy. After a walk through the Protico del Pavaglione, crossing the streets of the medieval market in front of the Loggia della Mercanzia (Loge des Marchands). The next stop is the discovery of the Basilica of Santo Stefano, better known as the complex of the "Seven Churches". The tour ends in the shadow of two symbols of the medieval city: Asinelli which is known as one of the tallest towers in Italy, and the Garisenda tower, which was also cited by Dante's "Inferno".

#### **Ferrara**

135 km from Rimini, Ferrara, a city with medieval and Renaissance testimonies

#### **Classical Half Day Itinerary**

The journey begins with a visit to the Schifanoia Palace, they say a "joy" to the family of Este. Here is the show for its frescoes of the 15th century, which are seen as representatives of the major fresco cycle of pagan Europe. The most famous local Renaissance painters worked there: Cosme Tura, Francesco del Cossa and Ercole de 'Roberti. The tour continues with a visit to the Cathedral, which has a Romanesque and Gothic style, with its apse from the Renaissance, then the honor courtyard of the palace of the Marquis, and shortly after the castle Este, it goes on in the city of the Renaissance with its large and elegant streets, characterized by the famous diamond palace.

The beauty of cycling - On discovery of Ferrara This route is recommended even for cyclists with les experience. Departure from the castle and on the bike path it comes to Ferrara to admire the famous defense system of the family D'Este. Continue with the medieval city, along the characteristic Via San Romano, old street of the medieval pilgrims and merchants. Arrival at the Cathedral of San Giorgio from the 12th century and the end of the tour. Cycle hire against charge, please contact us!

#### Comacchio

Comacchio is a little nice town in the Po Delta of Ferrara; the historic center is riddled with channels that can be crossed due to small and large bridges.

#### **Classical Half Day Itinerary**

The tour begins with the Marais Fattibello to the bridge Trepponti (Three Bridges), symbol of Comacchio from the 17th century, and ends in the old town, where are the "Loggia del Grano" (Lodge of wheat) and the bell tower. The trail continues to the Cathedral of San Cassiano, which has a characteristic tower. This former fishing village has been rebuilt in the 18th century during the reign of the papacy. Nevertheless, it is possible to visit the old "Manifattura dei Marinati" (production of pickles), which still marinate the eels tradionally. This activity was the only real source of income for the people of Comacchio. Within this building, which has just been restored, visitors can enjoy various functions such as the room "Sala dei fuochi" (firebox) with its 12 fireplaces, or "acetaia" (vinegar hall) and on this way they can understand better the stages of preparation of fish and the hard life of a man near the lagoon.


#### **Parma**

A Roman city that is rich of extraordinary Roman monuments and is the birthplace of Giuseppe Verdi and Arturo Toscanini and had its best times during the period of ducats of Parma, Piacenza and Guastalla. Today Parma is famous everywhere for the Royal Theatre, for its cuisine and the excellent quality of food: ham, parmesan cheese, meat, pasta much more.











#### Ravenna

Ravenna was the capital of the Roman Empire and has many monuments from this period with beautiful mosaics, which was also classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1997.

#### **Classical Half Day Itinerary**

The Mausoleum of Galla Placidia (fifth century, identification Unesco), the Basilica of San Vitale (sixth century, the identification of UNESCO), the Mausoleum of Theoderic (sixth century, the identification of UNESCO), the Basilica of Sant'Apollinare Nuovo (sixth century, Unesco identification), the Baptistery Neonian (identification Unesco).

#### **Faenza**

City of pottery and ceramics.

#### **Classical Half Day Itinerary**

The International Museum of Ceramics (techniques and the history of Italian production to date), the elegant residences in the historic center, Piazza del Popolo, Palazzo della Podestà, Palazzo dei Manfredi, Piazza della Libertà with the fountain from the seventeenth century and the Cathedral (fifteenth century).

#### Rimini

Famous seaside resort on the Adriatic coast with its center of Rimini, which suggests an ancient heart and has found especially its splendor in the recent years, gaining a majestic number of visitors and cultural developments.

#### **Classical Half Day Itinerary**

Tiberio Bridge, Corso d'Augusto, Arch of Augustus, Temple of Malatesta and its old town.

#### San Leo

32 km from Rimini, San Leo offers its visitors a perfectly preserved fortress.

#### **Classical Half Day Itinerary**

The fortress, the cathedral (twelfth century), la Pieve (ninth century), Palazzo Medici, the Museum of Sacred Art and the City Museum (exhibition of torture instruments).

#### Urbino

Urbino, which dates from the Renaissance. is the birthplace of Raffaello.

#### **Classical Half Day Itinerary**

Palazzo Ducale, Nationel Gallery of the Marche, the House of Raffaello, the medieval district of San Giovanni.

#### Gradara

A medieval picturesque village situated on a hill on which dominates the fortress Malatesta.

Visit oft he fortress with a walk along the small alleys oft he village.

#### Loreto

Loreto is the famous seat of the Basilica della Santa Casa one of the most important places of pilgrimage in the Catholic world. According to tradition, the house from the Virgin Mary was lifted up and transported in one night by angels from Nazareth to Loreto.

#### Genga/Frasassi caves

135 km from Rimini are the Frasassi caves that offer a spectacular stage and an unforgettable journey (Ancona Abyss, room 200, Grand Canyon, the hall of bears, infinity hall).

#### San Marino

25 km from Rimini is situated San Marino, which is the smallest and oldest republic in the world and was classified a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2008.

The tour begins at the San Marco Square and the Convent of San Marco (from the outside) and proceeds to the cathedral with its dome by Brunelleschi, the bell tower of Giotto, the Baptistery with the pearly gates of Ghiberti. You can visit the medieval quarter, with its houses, to Orsanmichele, a unique building in the Gothic style. Continue on to the "Piazza della Signoria", an open air museum, the Uffizi (from the outside), Ponte Vecchio.

#### **Fiesole**

Small village originally Etruscan and Roman who enjoys a panoramic position dominating the Arno Valley and who offers a beautiful view of Florence.

#### Vinci

Worldwide known of the birth of Leonardo, Vinci is a small village on the western slopes of Montalbano in the beloved and undulating countryside. Here everything is consecrated to the memories and the works of Leonardo, starting with the medieval castle of Guidi, who gives hospitality to the museum dedicated to Leonardo, a curious inventory of instruments, machines, realized projects or just qualified imaginations.

The Leonardo myth nourishes also the ideal Museum, situated in an old gallery of the castle. The route will be completed with a visit to the birth house of Leonardo in Anchiano, situated 2 kilometers away.

#### Arezzo

Located in the middle of Tuscany, in the convergence of 4 valleys which composes this province, Arezzo is a city with an illustrious past, starting from its Etruscan origins, while passing by its medieval history to arrive at the importance of the Renaissance, testified by works of Piero della Francesca.

#### Traditional route for a half day visit.

Church of San Francesco, which shelters the frescos of Piero della Francesca, the historical centre with Piazza Grande, Pieve de Santa Maria and the Cathedral, to end with the Church of San Domenico, which shelters Crocifisso of Cimabue. The route in the footsteps of Piero della Francesca, on Arezzo ground getting untied in Valtiberina, around the localities of San Sepolcro, Monterchi, native village from the mother Monna Romana and the town of Arezzo.

#### Carrara

This region is well known alla over the world for its marble. The streets are a series of enormous whit wounds which are split along the steep and primitive slopes where small streets replace gigantic blocks of stone. In Carrara the marble has been extracted for more than 2000 years. The white marble of Carrara has been processed in order to produce artistic and architectonic works which decorate the places, the palaces and houses all over the world.

#### Traditional route for a half day visit.

Visit to a sawmill and a marble workshop with explanations of alla the methods concerning work of the marble and operation of the machines used in the sawmill. The tour continues with the visit of an active street with explanations of the modern methods of extraction and the methods used in the past, with information about the technical, geological and petrographic nature. The excursion will end with a visit to a laboratory for the production of Lardo di Colonnata.

#### The Island of Elba

This is the largest of the minor Italian islands and is characterized by extremely steep rocky ridges interrupted occasionally by small bays and beaches. Elba is dominated by Mount Capanne (1018 meters), the highest point of the island. The vegetation is typically Mediterranean with olives, cactus plants, arbutus berries, chestnut trees and vines to produce delicious wines such as Aleatico and Moscato.

#### Lucca

#### Classical halfday itinerary

Walk through the historic center and the city walls of the Renaissance along: Cathedral of San Martino, San Frediano Basilica (with simple and elegant facade, has a small balcony with architrave decorated with Byzantine mosaics), Piazza San Michele (revitalized center and characterized by the city life ), Piazza Anfiteatro (number of medieval buildings, which were built around the theater and close the space as a ring, an impressive architectural creation), Piazza Napoleone.

#### Pisa

#### Classical halfday itinerary

Piazza del Duomo, also Campo dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles) gennant, where the main monuments of the Roman Pisan art are and where also the following monuments gather: The Bell Tower or Leaning Tower (the most famous tower in the world), the cathedral (one of the greatest masterpieces of Italian art), the Baptistery (majestic Gothic building with a circular ground plan), Campo Santo (rectangular building with blind arches and a beautiful veranda).

Saint Domenic's church (an important, Gothic basilica that houses Saint Catherine's Chapel and a tabernacle containing the reliquary of the saint), Via Banchi di Sopra, Tolomei Palace, Via di Città (the Medieval main road through the centre of the city), Chigi-Saracini Palace (which houses the prestigious Chigiana Music Academy), the Cathedral or Duomo (one of the most beautiful examples of Italian Romanesque-Gothic art), the Baptistery, Piazza del Campo (the shell valve-shaped heart of the city where the famous Palio is held) and Fonte Gaia.

#### Volterra

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

Piazza dei Priori (one of the most interesting and beautiful Medieval squares in Italy), which is surrounded by austere buildings such as Priori Palace, the Duomo or Cathedral and the Baptistery. Also worth visiting are the Etruscan necropolis and the Roman theatre.

#### **Baroque Rome**

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

The visit includes a tour of the main squares and fountains including the Trevi Fountain (the most famous and monumental fountain in the city), the Pantheon (the best preserved Roman monument from the era of Augustus), the piazza and church of San Luigi dei Francesi, Piazza Navona (a grand Baroque square) with Neptune's Fountain and the Fountain of the Four Rivers, with the allegorical statues of the Nile, Ganges, Danube and Rio della Plata, Rivers that symbolize the four parts of the world or in other words, Africa, Asia, Europe and America.

#### **Ancient Rome**

#### **Classical Halfday Itinerary**

The tour begins at the Colosseum, (where you can find the world's largest collection of tools from the Roman era) and the Arch of Constantine, built in 315, and restored in the eighteenth century. Continue on to the forum to see the remains of many buildings: the Basilica Aemilia, Basilica of Constantine, the Temple of Castor and Pollux and much more. The forum is dominated by the Capitol Hill, the symbol of the center of ancient Rome.

#### **Christian Rome**

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

The mystery of the ancient churches: the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Basilica of Saint John Lateran and the Basilica of Saint Paul outside the walls.

San Pietro Basilica (the largest and most imposing complex of Christian basilica, heart of the Christian world) and the famous square, with two notable obelisks and fountains of the seventeenth century in its center.

The Vatican Museums and Galleries deserve a special mention because they represent the entire history of art through the works of the most illustrious figures of each era. Suffice to mention the Sistine Chapel, frescoes by artists such as Pinturicchio, Perugino, Botticelli, Signorelli, Ghirlandaio and Michelangelo, Raphael's rooms, the Niccolina Chapel and the Art Gallery, which is full of masterpieces from throughout history.

#### **Ostia Antica**

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

Rome's old port boasts the square of the ancient "Corporation" (square of the Guilds), Cerere Temple, the theatre, Diana's house, the Decumanus Maximus (the main decuman road), the Forum, the Capitolium (Jupiter Temple) and the Baths of Neptune.

#### Tivoli

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

Villa Adriana (one of the most fascinating archaeological complexes dating from Roman times), with the imposing ruins of the villa commissioned by the Emperor Adrian and Villa d'Este with its wonderful gardens.

#### The Castelli Romani

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

This is an excursion into the lush green hillside that surrounds Rome, to Castelgandolfo (the Pope's summer residence), Nemi and its lakes, and Frascati.


#### Cassino

The abbey, which is situated on the top of Mount Cassino (516 m), can be reached by a small road that winds its way along the mountain's rocky side, offering spectacular panoramic views of the surrounding area.

#### **Tarquinia**

#### **Classical Halfday Itinerary**

Visit of the National Etruscan Museum, inside the Palazzo Vitelleschi (duration 1.5 hours). Then go down to 3 km distance to Necropolis with its valuable painted tombs, which is one of the largest complexes of ancient painting and only comparable to those of Egypt (duration 1.5 hours).

#### Viterbo, city of the Popes

#### Classical Halfday Itinerary

The start of the tour is at the Cathedral Square with the Pope's Palace, its loggia and the Cathedral. Then it goes on with visiting the facade of the Palazzo Farnese in the direction of the medieval quarter of San Pellegrino with the oldest houses in the city that are decorated with arches, balconies and stairs outside the house. At the end of the visit it goes towards the Roman church of Santa Maria Nuova with its original Lombard monastery to admire the numerous fountains of the city, until arriving at « Piazza del Comune » with the « Palazzo dei Priori ».

#### Cerveteri

The city is located beside the ancient site of Caere (the Etruscan Kysry), one of the most important commercial centers which is famous for its necropolis. The necropolis of Banditaccia provides the best example of the Etruscan grave architecture. You can hike through the marked roads, which let appear it such as wonderful placer, where everything, even the equipment of the grave chambers are made of tuff. A real city of the dead where the evolution of species of the grave stones are arranged by circular hills to square tombs along an orthogonal axis, which gives an idea of the cityscape of the colonies of the VII century.



#### **Assisi**

The history of its famous Saints Francis and Clare combined with the history of some of the most important artists from the middle Ages.

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

Saint Clare's Basilica where Saint Clare is buried and where it is possible to visit the Christ Crucified to whom Saint Francis spoke. Saint Francis' Basilica is the centre of Franciscan spirituality and the birthplace of middle-aged art, built on the grave of the saint of Assisi. The latter was built on two levels above the tomb of the saint. It is an architectural masterpiece that houses some of the best Medieval Italian art with pieces by Cimabue, Giotto, Simone Martini and Pietro Lorenzetti.

#### Perugia

This has always been Umbria's main town and is situated on high ground that offers spectacular panoramic views over the region. The centre can be reached thanks to a modern system of escalators.

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

The most important monuments are Rocca Paolina (a fortress), Fontana Maggiore, Priori Palace and the Etruscan Arch.

#### Gubbio

This beautifully preserved medieval town hosts the crazy "Corsa dei Ceri" (Race of the Candles).

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

The most important monuments are Piazza Consoli and Consoli Palace, the church of Saint Francis and the Duomo or Cathedral.

#### Todi

This pleasant town is situated on a hillside in central Umbria.

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

At the foot of the town, the Tempio della Consolazione, a beautiful Renaissance temple built following a miracle, the Franciscan church of San Fortunato and the main square, which is overlooked by three municipal palaces and the Duomo or Cathedral.

#### Orvieto

The town, which was founded by the Etruscans, is situated on top of a tufa cliff that can be reached by a funicular.

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

The Duomo or Cathedral, the Palazzo del Popolo and the medieval quarter, a visit to churches and palaces under the golden light of tufa. Also worth seeing is the church of San Giovanni.

#### Visit Orvieto Underground

A pleasant visit which makes it possible to discover the undergrounds of the city, realized by the former inhabitants in 2.500 years of uninterrupted excavations. A one hour tour to discover a surprising thousand-year-old underground city.

#### Norcia

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

The church of Saint Benedict, the Castellina, the church of Sant'Agostino, the Cathedral of Santa Maria Argentea and the "Tempietto".

#### **Spoleto**

#### Typical itinerary for a half-day visit.

Torri Bridge (which was also admired by Goethe), the Cathedral or Duomo, the Roman theatre, which is still used for performances during the Spoleto Festival and can be visited along with the Archaeological Museum (entrance fee payable) and the Crypt of Sant'Ansano.

#### Lake Trasimeno

A typical visit. Situated in the very heart of Umbria and covering a total of 128 square km, this is the largest lake on the peninsula and it is famous thanks to Roman battles fought here. It has three islands, Polvese (which is the largest), Maggiore (the most populated) and Minore, which is uninhabited and is a destination for nature tourism.

## BAY OF NAPLES and sorrento

## Naples

Naples today is the largest city in the south of Italy and the third most populated in the whole country. Departure by bus for Naples and visit to the National Archaeological Museum. We recommend you to visit Posillipo, Martellina and Via Caracciolo, the coast, Santa Lucia (a picturesque fishing village) Castel dell'Ovo, the Royal Palace, San Carlo theatre, Umberto I Gallery and Angioino Keep. The visit proceeds to Solfatara, with a visit to the still active crater.

#### **Naples Underground**

#### www.napolisotterranea.org

The origins of Naples, admired by a legendary halo, are dated back form history. Caves were dugged in basements to extract the tuff and to shelter the holy rites of the first inhabitants. On the basis of Piazza San Gaetano, which is not other than the place of the market of former Naples, one will discover a city in the city. In San Lorenzo Maggiore one will see another archaeological zone where workshops were discovered, tabernacles and the seat of Aerarium, where the public Treasury of the city was preserved.

#### Caserta

Caserta is known for the famous Reggia, but the city offers the possibility to very interesting visits, as its ancient history and its development, which is derived from the various folks who have benefited from the rich territory, before it was occupied by the Samnites, and later by Romans and Lombards, and in the middle Ages by the Byzanthinen, Swabia and Catalens But it was the bourbon, one of the largest and most important royal houses of Europe, which decided in 1750 to build the Royal Palace, since it was necessary to have a residence that was as far as possible from the sea to seek protection in case of attack. A visit to the Royal Palace in Caserta is breathtaking. It starts with apartments in the palace, the park, between Italian and English gardens with beautiful fountains, waterfalls and forests. The visit of the Interior is without tourist guide.

#### Pompeii and Vesuvius

Departure for Pompeii, where there is a guided visit to the excavations. Departure for Vesuvius on foot and the crater, which stands about 1,000 meters above sea level.

#### Herculaneum

An ancient city in the Gulf of Naples, close to the sea, at the foot of Mount Vesuvius. Together with Pompeii, it was buried by the eruption of Vesuvius in 79 AD. Like Pompeii, it is an archaeological site of note.

#### Ischia

This is a volcanic island that covers 42 square km, making it the largest in the Gulf of Naples. Full day tour with escort. Departure by ferryboat or hydrofoil from Sorrento for Ischia. Tour of the island by private bus passing through Barano, Casamicciola, Lacco Ameno and Serrata Fontana with a stop along the way to enjoy the spectacular panoramic views.

#### Capri and Anacapri

Capri is famous throughout the world for its Faraglioni rocks and its "Grotta Azzurra". It is an extremely beautiful island that retains a number of monuments that bear witness to its glorious past. This includes the Greek Acropolis (4th - 5th century B.C.), the Baths of Tiberius and Villa Jovis. From the port of "Marina Grande", there is a funicular that takes visitors to the "Piazzetta" which thanks to its elegant boutiques and characteristic narrow streets is an obligatory stop for all shopping enthusiasts. Also very popular are Villa San Michele and Museum, and the Charterhouse of Saint James. A typical visit. Departure by ferry from Sorrento to Capri and a tour of the island by private bus. In Anacapri the tour will visit Villa San Michele and there will be a walk to the Gardens of Augustus, where there are spectacular panoramic views of the famous Faraglioni rocks

#### **Amalfi Coast**

The Amalfi Coast is the most spectacular seascape in Europe. Full day tour by bus with guide. A spectacular tour of the coastline with an initial stop in Positano. The tour proceeds to Amalfi (including a visit to the Cathedral) where there is also an opportunity to visit the emerald caves. Departure to Ravello for a visit of Villa Rufolo. Free time for shopping.

#### **Paestum**


The city of Poseidonia, near the sea in the gulf of Salerno, was founded by the Achaeans in the seventh century BC and is still today the most interesting architectural nucleus: encircled by 4,750 meters of walls, it has three Doric temples - the Basilica, the Temple of Neptune, and the Temple of Ceres - and other minor temples.

## Visit a mozzarella of buffalo laboratory

Paestum and Cilento are the places, between ground and sea, in charge with art and history, rich in tastes and typical savors. The buffalo mozzarella is a typical cheese of this area. Along the road which goes from Battipaglia o Capaccio (Paestum), you will find dozens of cheese dairies where you can taste this delicious specialty.

#### Puglia Bari

Although this is a large, modern-looking city, it was already, founded in the pre-Roman period. A wonderful group of Romanesque churches encircles the old town centre and Bari retains the atmosphere, narrow uphill streets, stone steps and walls of a compact, mediaeval hamlet standing on a small peninsula that divides the harbor in two, with three churches in the centre.

#### A typical itinerary for a half day visit.

The Basilica of Saint Nicholas, a popular place of pilgrimage, Svevo Castle and the Cathedral of Saint Sabino.

# In the footspetps of the templers, visit to Sovereto

It is one of the most attractive and mysterious places of this ground. A very small and old borough, where time passes in an unreal silence. This place, already known in antiquity, has been seen as sacred (in the surroundings there are menhirs or "pietrefittes". testimonies of old worships). But the charm of this place is the medieval complex which includes a small medieval church and what remained of a hospital which used to have cruisers and pilgrims directly from the Holy Land. Its history crosses, without any doubt, with the Templers who were very present in this area. And one of them, called Romaldo de Bolenae who was the Tutor of the Templers, has been buried in this small church (today private property). But with his sepulchral inscription, the mystery starts. There was written "preceptor" and not "praeceptor" as it would have been written. And considering that the events of Templers were connected to that of Graal, somebody supposed that it is about a contributing message to give useful indications to his discovery...

#### Lecce

This city is mainly famous for its extraordinary Baroque architecture, whose exuberant decorations are supported by the nature of the local stone, which is golden and soft to the scalpel.

#### A typical itinerary for a half day visit.

Porta Napoli, Via Calmieri, Piazza Duomo and the Cathedral, the Bishop's Palace and Seminary, Piazza S.Oronzo, the Basilica of the Holy Cross, the Museum of the Roman Theatre, San Matteo and the old town centre.

#### **Castel Del Monte**

This is the most beautiful building in Puglia and one of the most delightful mediaeval castles ever built. Its characteristic features include the perfect balance of its eight towers, commissioned by Frederick II in 1240.

#### Alberobello

This interesting and particularly picturesque town consists entirely of famous "trulli" (there are about a thousand); low buildings with a conical roof.

#### Castellana Caves

Thanks to their immense size and depth and the numerous stalagmites and stalactites, they are without doubt the most spectacular caves in Italy. They are 60 meters under ground and extend for around 3 km.

#### **Taranto**

This was an important Spartan colony in the 8th century BC and subsequently a Roman settlement. The old town is on an island, between the gulf and the huge, internal port.

#### A typical itinerary for a half day visit.

#### Palermo

SicilY

As its name suggests, the city was a meeting point between East and West. In fact "Panormus" means large port. Typical itinerary for a half-day tour.

## sardinia

#### Cagliari

On Golf degli Angeli is located Cagliari, a city that was founded by the Phoenicians in ancient times. As tourism and cultural policy, economic center of Sardinia, it extends over seven hills: Castello Colle San Michele, Colle di Bonaria Urpinu Monte, Monte Claro, Tuvumannu and Tuvixeddu. The city that is owned by towers and imposing bastions of the largest and most important Punic necropolis in the Mediterranean basin, namely the Tuvixeddu, whose archaeological remains are kept in the Archaeological Museum.

#### Barumini

The village is known worldwide thanks to the Su Nuraxi, an example of a monumental Nuraghe, protected site by UNESCO. The Nuraghe Su Nuraxi, at the entrance of the village, is one of the most impressive expressions of Sardinian megalithic civilization.

#### Alghero

Alghero, the capital of the "Riviera del Corallo", still preserves traditions and language of Catalonia that has shaped the city for centuries, although its history is much older, as evidenced by Palma Nuraghe Vera and Sant'Imbenia. In the marine reserve of Capo Caccia -Isola Piana, is situated the Nettuno grotto, with spectacular stalactites and stalagmites.

#### Nuoro

Surrounded by the green valleys of Monte Ortobene, is situated the city of Nuoro, as the Domus de Janas and Nuraghes where stone axes and pottery and obsidian were found.

The Ethnographic Museum with traditional costumes, carnival masks of Barbagie, carpets, figures in bread and cakes is always a surprise for the visitors.

#### Orgosolo

The village is characterized by its murals on the facades of houses and on the rocks around the village, which reflects social, artistic and political issues.

The "Coro a tenores", the traditional singing of the Barbagie has been included in the World Heritage Site of UNESCO.

#### Pula

The city of Pula is well known thanks to the ancient village of Nora. Around Pula you can visit archaeological sites.

#### Cabras

A few kilometers from Oristano is situated Cabras, a small village, which consists of one-floor houses, since ancient times, they preserved its urban form. It lies on the edge of the pond of the same name, one of the largest freshwater lakes of Sardinia, which is connected to the sea by a series of canals.

#### Castelsardo

Castelsardo is a nice little seaside town, and it is exactly the sea, which makes the story. The village was a defensive fortress and a place of strategic control. The old city still exists with its medieval fortress, with its impressive bastions, steep stairs and narrow streets.
